

BILL 30 IS A DANGER TO OUR WORKING CONDITIONS

Bill 30 threatens the working conditions we have won through almost 40 years of bitter struggles.

The employer associations and the government are using Bill 30 to transfer 26 matters in our collective agreement to the local level.

These include working conditions as important as:

- the recall list;
- filling jobs and job requirements;
- hours of work and work week;
- overtime;
- vacations and statutory holidays;
- human resources development;
- the bumping procedure;
- rules on temporary assignments;
- leave without pay.



We refuse to submit to the game of local bargaining. We demand a process of genuine national collective bargaining on the basis of our current collective agreement.

There is a lot that needs to be improved in our working conditions. We refuse to let them be rolled back through a decentralization of bargaining that will only favour management.
